January 5 - 1 6, 2024, COVID 19 0B declared for RSL only. 23 cases, 18 positive, 5 negatives, 2 deaths and 1 hospitalization.

January 1 9, 2024 - Present - COVID 19 and RSV 0B declared for BJW, 1 1 cases, 2 positives for COVID 19, 4 positives for RSV, all others negative. No deaths or hospitalizations.

Vaccinations:

Resident Flu - 91%

Staff Flu - 80%

Resident COVID - 88%

Resident RSV - 54%

RSV vaccine is still available for eligible residents.

Hand Hygiene Stats:

34 observations sessions for the month of December with a 100.0% compliance rate.

Resident hand hygiene is offered and encouraged before meals and activities. audited on a weekly basis with an overall success rate of 100%.
