



Valentines Day originated as a Christian feast day honoring

a martyr named Valentine and through later folk traditions, it has also become a significant cultural, religious, and commercial celebration of romance and love in many regions of the world. A Valentine's card, c. 1909. By some accounts, St. Valentine was a Roman priest and physician who suffered martyrdom during the persecution of Christians by the emperor Claudius II Gothicus about 270. He was buried on the Via Flaminia, and Pope Julius I reportedly built a basilica over his grave. St. Valentine was beaten with clubs, beheaded, and buried near the Flaminian way in Rome. He is sometimes called St Valentine of Rome, but the diocese of Terni claims him as Bishop of Narnia and say he was only visiting Rome when he was arrested and martyred. Tradition has it that St .Valentine mission involved marrying Christian couples according to the rites of the church. Making these marriages possible is part of the reason he is patron of lovers and happy marriages. Of course, St. Valentines own great love was Christ, and it was evangelism that got him arrested in the 20th century. Hallmark cards produced Valentine's cards in 1913 and then the tradition of red roses, chocolates etc. really took off. There is nothing left of St Valentine except his name. However, St Valentine's relics as Rome, Madrid, Slovenia (where he is patron of beekeepers) to mention just a few.
